Election Results and Seat Board members

- Troy- Went over results- John Berger won with 21 votes out of 37 (57%). Troy asks board to change the way voting is conducted (i.e. paper ballot, specific hours, etc.)

Enrollment and Lottery Update

Total enrollment- 908. Wait list- 199 Gail asked about the undecided students- asked how long they have to decide, noted that it's not really fair to those on the waiting list. Board discussed possibility of creating a specific deadline for those undecided. Students cannot officially be taken out of the system until requests are received from another school.

Lots of events- one almost every night for the last month. Sam noted that the skill and commitment level of students who go here is unbelievable.

❖ Financial Report - MaryAnn Oram

o Financials and Budget Review

- Finances are looking great. Quarterly report shows debt service coverage ratio (1.4) and days cash on hand (98) are all trending upward.
- Next month is when we need this year's budget and next year's budget approved.
- O Performance based increases for next fiscal year-considering having max increase of 4.5% All teachers will receive a cost of living increase, the other piece is performance evaluation. Sam created a chart of 40 points to evaluate teachers. Bette suggested it would be nice to give a title to those teachers

- who achieve the high score at one point or another. Neil agrees- recognition and compensation would be great.
- MaryAnn started creating a 5-year budget. WPU has gone up every single year since Vista has started, MaryAnn used that to help project budget in those areas.
- O Bette asked how teachers feel about funding for classroom supplies/curriculum. Teacher survey shows that most feel there is sufficient funding. Bette noted that it's important that they know they can at least ask for extra funding. Gail suggested that when teachers want funding above what is normally issued, they create a sort or request for those funds explaining how students would benefit from the funding. Neil suggests to compare funding for certain programs here to those at other schools.
