Halloween

Halloween will be celebrated on Tues Oct 31. It is a minimum day for 1st - 8th grade students, with school dismissed at 12:55pm.

Kindergarten students will have a shorter day so that both AM and PM classes can come to school in costume. AM classes will arrive at 8:25am and will need to be picked up at10:25am. Please be prompt in picking up your child. PM classes will arrive at 10:55amand will need to be picked up at 12:55pm.

All kindergarteners will parade in their costumes at the beginning of their class and then return to class for Halloween activities. We understand if your child will not be able to attend because of the schedule change. Because of early pickup that day, AM students will not need to bring a lunch. PM students, please eat an early lunch before you come to school. Snacks will be served that day.

Parents are invited to watch the annual Halloween Costume Parade on Tues Oct 31 at 8:35 am. Please allow time to park and walk into the school. There is limited parking in the parking lot, and plenty of parking on Park Avenue Drive. Parents will be able to viewthe parade in the gym. PM Kindergarten students will also have a parade; details will come directly from your child's Kindergarten teacher.

Vista School costume rules include no masks or covering over faces, no weapons, no face paint. This rule applies during the parade, as well.

After School/VCC Pickup

Please pick up your student on time, either at the end-of-school bell, or as soon as VCC classes end. Children may not be unsupervised after school. We have many students waiting for siblings to finish in their VCC classes but siblings are not permitted inside the building if they are not enrolled in a class. Online Lunch Payments

While payment by cash or check can still be paid at the front office, there is a new payment system for lunch by credit card. Do not click on Make a Payment on the school website home page. Instead, choose the Parent tab and click on Breakfast/Lunch. Then select Make a Lunch Payment. Account setup is required the first time this site is accessed. The system will automatically notify you when there is a low balance. You can set up recurring payments. E-check adds a .49 fee for each payment. Credit card adds a 3% fee plus a \$1.50 minimum for each payment.
