A/B Schedule


Mondays and Wednesdays = A Day Tuesdays and Thursdays = B Day Fridays = A or B Day

Free Dress Days

Last Day of School - Minimum Day

Thurs May 24 is the last day of school for 1st-8th grade students. Classes will follow a Friday schedule. This is a free dress day but modesty rules will be enforced and those who do not follow Vista standards will be sent home or required to change.

- board shorts
- no holes in clothing
- skirts
