Students and Parents,

I wanted to make each of you aware that on Monday morning, October 22, Vista will be conducting a Lock-in/Lockout drill. This is different from a lock down. In a Lockin/Lock-out, we will be focusing on what the school would do if there were a danger outside the building or in the neighborhood, such as a bank robbery down the street or a domestic situation in the neighborhood. Teachers will NOT stop class and barricade/hide with their students. We will work on making sure that all access points in the building are secure and students are accounted for. Teachers will then be free to continue teaching, but will not release students for class changes until the drill is over. Hopefully this will not make students anxious or concerned while we practice improving our safety.

Halloween will be celebrated on Wed Oct 31. It is a minimum day for 1st - 8th grade students, with school dismissed at 12:55pm.
