#### School Breakfast

Breakfast is served from 7:50-8:15am. Note the new times.

- Regular pay \$1.00/meal
- · Reduced \$.30/meal

If you qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch, then you qualify for Free/Reduced Breakfast.

#### School Lunch

Regular pay \$2.50/meal, Reduced \$.40/meal, Second meal/Adult/Non-Vista student option \$3.00/meal, whether you are full pay, reduced or free.

#### **Online Lunch Payments**

Cash or check payments are accepted at the front office. For payment by credit card, do not click on Make a Payment on the school website home page. Instead, choose the Parent tab and click on Breakfast/Lunch. Then select Make a Lunch Payment. Account setup is required the first time this site is accessed. The system will automatically notify you when there is a low balance. You can set up recurring payments. E-check adds a .49 fee for each payment. Credit card adds a 3% fee plus a \$1.50 minimum for each payment.

## **Uniform donation**

If you have uniforms (tops or bottoms) that your child will no longer be wearing, please consider donating them to the front office. Donations are used throughout the year for students who have a need for a change of clothes during the school day.
