# **Bus Transportation**



The owner/operator of TBG Transportation (formerly VTO), has indicated that the company will be closing and will no longer provide services after Mon Sept 30. Vista School does not own or operate a bus service and only learned of this decision over the past weekend. We

know this causes frustration and concern about how your children will get to school.

As this is the second time in three years that bus service owners have chosen to stop providing services, there is a question as to whether Vista should continue to rely upon this private service. A feasibility study and cost projections are being run to consider whether or not to bring this service in-house but there is no immediate solution.

Mr. Gibbs will hold a transportation meeting in the choir room on Mon Sept 30 at 6:00pm to answer questions and facilitate temporary carpool groups until a long term solution can be reached. Thank you for your patience during this interruption of service beginning Tues Oct 1.
