Record their answers in Spanish. You must submit the audio or video recording of your interview along with your list of interview questions.

- Create a personal grammar “cheat sheet” or “grammar rules” for important grammar principles you have learned. Have it bound for personal use. Minimum of 15 grammar rules (attach a copy of your dictionary unbound).
- Watch any of the following documentaries and attach a review in English (300 word minimum. Maximum 1 documentary) (attach a copy)

  - Mariachi High
  - Ciudades de Latinoamérica
  - Perú, Tesoro Escondido (Peru, Hidden Treasure)
- Serve Spanish speaking members in our community. Create your own service opportunity or find something near you. The following are ideas only. You must have pre-approval from Mrs. Jones
  - Read to students in English or Spanish who speak Spanish in the home.
  - Find someone who wants to practice having a conversation in English.
  - Tutor an individual
  - Etc.
- Research a festival/celebration/holiday specific to a Spanish speaking country. Create a presentation or write a report about the festival (attach a copy).
